Approved by the Ministry of the Interior and Ministry of Education, the International Chinese Kuoshu Federation (ICKF) was founded in 1978 in the wake of a World Chinese Kuoshu Tournament held in Tainan in October of 1975 (later termed as the 1st tournament) under the President Mr. Tsai Hung-weng, and afterwards, the tournament continued to take place on a four years basis. The last one, the 9th World Chinese Kuoshu Tournament, was held in Tainan in 2004. Over the past years, the ICKF has contributed remarkably to cultivating outstanding kuoshu coaches, referees and kuoshu experts in terms of both techniques and morality

Regrettably, we found that members of the ICKF, Mr. Huang Chien-liang (USA), Mr. Li Wing Kay (Brazil) and Mr. Tan Ching Ngee (Singapore) organized the so-called 1st World Kuoshu Tournament in 2004 and the 2nd one in 2006 by using the name of ICKF without its approval, seriously violating the regulations as stated in Article 11, Chapter 3, the Constitution of the ICKF.

It was decided at the Session of an Extraordinary General Assembly, ICKF that according to the rules of the ICKF, Mr. Huang Chien-liang, Mr. Li Wing-Kay and Mr. Tan Ching Ngee are suspended from the membership of ICKF, including invalidity of certificates of coach, referee and degree of Tuan granted by the ICKF and discharge from any positions in the organization of the ICKF, effective from now onwards.

The same disciplinary actions will be applied to any one in the Republic of China, who, if found, would collude with them doing such activity as mentioned above.
